April 15 <sup>th</sup>	One-Stop early voting begins
May 1 <sup>st</sup>	One-Stop early voting ends at 1:00 p.m.
May 4 <sup>th</sup>	Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.
May 4 <sup>th</sup>	Wayne County Board of Elections Board Meeting – 2:00 p.m. Absentee Ballot Tabulation (Note: Absentee results will not be released until the polls close.)
May 4 <sup>th</sup>	Wayne County Board of Elections Board Meeting – 7:30 p.m. Transfer Ballot Tabulation
May 4 <sup>th</sup>	<b>UNOFFICIAL ELECTION RESULTS</b> – 7:30 p.m. until all precinct results are reported. (NOTE: All election night results are considered unofficial until Canvass is complete and the Wayne County Board of Elections certifies results.)
May 10 <sup>th</sup> (Tentative)	A tentative date of Monday, May 10 <sup>th</sup> , has been set to review precinct tapes, provisional ballots, and conduct any recounts required by law. A public notice will be distributed upon approval by the Wayne County Board of Elections, confirming the date and time.
May 11 <sup>th</sup>	Wayne County Board of Elections Canvass – 11:00 a.m. – Election results will be certified by the Wayne County Board of Elections.
