



Step 1:
Complete handwashing
station



Step 2:
Wet hands Completely



Step 3:
Apply antibacterial soap



Step 4:
Lather and scrub hands and
forearms outside of the
water for 20 seconds



Step 5:
Use nail brush to clean un-
der nails. Note: Always
maintain a clean and sani-
tized brush for use.



Step 6:
Rinse for 10 seconds, includ-
ing forearms

Dry hands thoroughly



Step 8:
Turn off the faucet with **paper
towel** when necessary. Note: If air
dryer is used, recommend provid-
ing paper towels to turn off faucet.

Open door with paper
