In-Home Services

Wayne County Services on Aging In-Home Services provide trained aides to help older persons remain in or return to their homes with maximum personal independence. The services include help with personal care, planning and preparing meals, and household tasks that cannot be managed alone.

Services can reduce the need for continued hospital or convalescent nursing home care.

Pathway of Hope

Pathway of Hope is a Group Respite Day Program designed to help caregivers and families coping with Alzheimer's Disease and other memory loss conditions.

The program provides temporary relief to caregivers while giving the participants an opportunity to engage in social & recreational activities that are designed to maximize cognitive and social skills in a secure & safe environment that enhances a good quality of life.
