Wayne County Public Library and Services on Aging Postpone Events

Wayne County, NC – Following recommendations from state and local health officials, Wayne County management has made the decision to postpone large events at the Wayne County Public Library and Peggy M. Seegars Senior Center.

Guidance released from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services on March 12, 2020 recommends that large gatherings where people are in close contact be postponed or cancelled. The health and safety of our residents is our number one priority and this decision comes out of an abundance of caution during the COVID-19 outbreak affecting our state.

We ask that anyone showing or feeling symptoms of sickness to remain home and not visit library locations or the senior center until you are feeling well.
