- Town of Pikeville–(Mayor & 2 At-Large Commissioner seats) – Filing Fee \$5
- Village of Walnut Creek–(2 At-Large Councilman seats) – Filing Fee \$5

***Town of Mount Olive Elections/Filing Period**

[Session Law 2021-56](#) postpones Town of Mount Olive elections until March, 2022. Because 2021 is a year following the federal census, some municipalities must redistrict in order to correct population imbalances. Therefore, filing periods and election dates for district-based contests are delayed and filing periods are subject to change as they are contingent on the timeliness of the U.S. Census Bureau releasing data and state and local governments adopting redistricting plans based on that data. Candidate filing for the Town of Mount Olive elections is tentatively scheduled for December, 2021.

What do I need to bring?

- Valid photo ID for notarization purposes;
- Cash, check or money order for filing fees - must include name/address pre-printed on check – no credit cards.

What to expect:

- If arriving on the first or last day of filing, please be prepared to wait;
- Election Officials will initially verify your eligibility to file for office;
- If qualified, filing paperwork will be completed & signed/notarized - filing fee must be paid at time of filing.

Campaign Finance

- Candidates have 10 days post-filing to submit *Statement of Organization* paperwork (regardless of Office sought, all filers establish a Committee & therefore must adhere to NC Campaign Finance law);
- If you have a previous campaign committee with our office, please be sure to notify Election Official & verify all information is current and accurate.
